How Fiber Optic Internet Works

Fiber optic internet transmits data as pulses of light through ultra-thin glass or plastic strands, offering high-speed, low-latency, and reliable connectivity compared to traditional copper cables . The fiber line enters your home or office and connects to an Optical Network Terminal (ONT), which converts the optical signals into electrical signals that your router can interpret . In some setups, the ONT and router may be combined into a single device.

Required Equipment

To connect fiber optic internet to your router, you typically need:

- Optical Network Terminal (ONT): Provided by your ISP, it converts light signals into data .
- Fiber optic cable: Usually thin and flexible, with connectors like SC/APC or SC/UPC .
- Router: Must support fiber input, often via a WAN or SFP port, and be capable of handling high-speed connections .
- Ethernet cable: Connects the ONT to the router's WAN port, ensuring full-speed data transfer .
- Power cables: For both the ONT and router....
