Optical fiber cables are composed of five main structural components: the core, cladding, coating, strength members, and outer jacket, each serving a critical role in signal transmission and cable protection.

Core

The core is the central part of the fiber, made of ultra-pure silica glass or sometimes plastic, which carries light signals over long distances. Its diameter determines the type of fiber: single-mode fibers typically have a 8–10 μm core for long-distance, high-bandwidth transmission, while multimode fibers have 50–62.5 μm cores for shorter distances and multiple light paths. The core's purity and precision are essential to minimize signal loss and maintain high transmission efficiency .

Cladding

Surrounding the core is the cladding, a layer of glass or plastic with a lower refractive index than the core. This difference causes total internal reflection, keeping light confined within the core and preventing signal leakage. The cladding ensures efficient light propagation and reduces attenuation over long distances .

Coating

The coating or buffer layer is a protective polymer layer applied over the cladding. I...
