Optical cable testing is classified into mechanical, optical, and environmental tests, further divided into type, acceptance, and routine testing to ensure performance, reliability, and compliance with standards.

1. Types of Optical Cable Testing

Mechanical Tests: These simulate physical stresses during installation and operation, such as tensile strength, bending, impact, and crush resistance. They ensure the cable maintains optical performance, including fiber strain and attenuation, under mechanical stress (IEC 60794-1-21, E1-E20) . **Optical Tests:** These assess signal transmission and integrity:

- **Insertion Loss Testing:** Measures total optical loss through the fiber link to verify compliance with design loss budgets .
 - **Return Loss and Reflectance Testing:** Evaluates light reflected back toward the source, which can degrade signal quality .
 - **OTDR (Optical Time-Domain Reflectometer) Testing:** Detects faults, bends, and splice losses along the fiber length .
 - **Visual Fault Locator (VFL):** Identifies breaks or tight bends using visible light .
 - **Fiber Inspection Probes:** Examine connector endfaces for contamination or damage .
- Environmental Tests:** These simulate conditions like temperature extremes, humidity, water immersion, and UV exposure to ensure long-term reliability
