

There is a gap at the top of the distribution box

A gap at the top of a distribution box often indicates either an installation adjustment issue or a design feature, and it can usually be corrected by adjusting the panel face or using appropriate fillers.

Causes of the Gap

A gap at the top of a distribution box can occur due to several reasons:

- **Panel installation alignment:** Surface-mounted or flush-mounted panels may not sit perfectly against the wall, leaving a visible gap. Some panels have adjustable faces to bring the cover flush with the breakers .
- **Design tolerances:** Certain panel models, like Siemens or Square D NF, may have a small intentional gap to allow the cover to hinge properly. These gaps can range from 1/16" to 3/4" depending on the model .
- **Incorrect mounting:** If the panel is recessed or not level, the top may not align with the cover, creating a larger gap than intended .

Corrective Measures

- **Adjust the panel face:** Many panels have screws or mounting adjustments that allow the internal face to move forward or backward to reduce the gap . Check the manufacturer's instructions for your specific model.
- **Use filler materials:** If the gap is small (less than 1/4"), acrylic latex caulk can be used to fill it. For larger or uneven gaps, minimally expanding foam sealant is reco...
