

Thickness of steel plate used in electrical distribution box manufacturing

Steel plate thickness for electrical distribution boxes typically ranges from 1.2 mm to 2.0 mm, depending on box type, size, and installation environment.

Standard Thickness Guidelines

- Switch Boxes: Minimum steel thickness is 1.2 mm for standard switch box enclosures, suitable for indoor or lightly stressed environments .
- Distribution Boxes: Minimum steel thickness is 1.5 mm, which provides adequate protection for general residential and commercial applications .
- Floor-Standing Cabinets / Large Units: Thickness increases to 2.0 mm for heavy-duty or industrial applications, large freestanding units, or boxes exposed to high mechanical stress, wind loads, or vibration .

Size and Environmental Considerations

- Box Width and Semi-Perimeter: For boxes wider than 500 mm but less than 800 mm, steel thickness should not be less than 1.2 mm; for widths ≥ 800 mm, thickness should be ≥ 1.5 mm. For household boxes with a semi-perimeter ≥ 900 mm, thickness should be ≥ 1.5 mm; for meter boxes or non-standard boxes with semi-perimeter ≥ 1100 mm, thickness should be ≥ 2.0 mm .
- Waterproof or Outdoor Boxes: Standard 1.5 mm steel is sufficient for mid-sized units in protected outdoor areas, while 2.0 mm is recommended for harsh environments, coastal areas, or high-vibration industrial sites to prevent warping an...
