

Thickness requirements for vertical supports of cable trays



Article Overview

Vertical supports for cable trays typically use steel or stainless steel side rails with material thicknesses ranging from 1.5 mm to 3 mm, depending on load and installation type.

Material and Standards

Vertical cable tray supports are generally made from galvanized or stainless steel to ensure mechanical strength and corrosion resistance . The thickness of the side rails or vertical supports is determined by the maximum permissible cable dead weight, the height of the tray, and the fastening spacing. For standard vertical cable ladders and trays, material thicknesses commonly range from 1.5 mm to 3 mm, with thicker profiles used for higher loads or wider trays .

Load and Fastening Considerations

- Maximum cable dead weight: Vertical supports are designed to handle typical cable loads up to 20 kg/m for standard installations .
- Fastening spacing: Supports are usually fastened to walls or ceilings at intervals of ≤ 1.2 m, with additional reinforcement required for longer vertical runs .
- Rungs and side rails: Rungs are often C-profiled with slot widths suitable for clamps, and side rails must be thick enough to prevent bending or deformation under load .
