

Two-in two-out optical fiber cable with 4 cores



Article Overview

A two-in, two-out optical fiber cable with 4 cores allows two input fibers to split into two output fibers, typically using singlemode or multimode cores, suitable for indoor/outdoor applications with redundancy options.

Overview

A 4-core optical fiber cable is commonly used when two separate input signals need to be routed to two outputs, providing redundancy or multiple channels in a compact design. Each fiber core can carry a single channel of data, and the cable can be configured as singlemode (OS2) for long-distance transmission or multimode (OM1-OM5) for shorter distances and higher bandwidth applications .

Two-In, Two-Out Configuration

The two-in, two-out (bifurcated) design splits the input fibers into separate output fibers, often using a Y-cable or fanout bundle. This allows one input to feed two outputs or two inputs to feed two outputs simultaneously. Such cables are typically encased in stainless steel or durable polymer tubing for protection and may include SMA905 or FC/PC connectors for easy integration .
