PON fiber optic connectors link the Optical Line Terminal (OLT) to Optical Network Units (ONUs) or Terminals (ONTs), enabling high-speed, passive distribution of data, voice, and video over single-mode fiber.

Overview of PON Connectivity

In a Passive Optical Network (PON), a single fiber from the OLT is split passively to serve multiple end users through optical splitters, eliminating the need for powered devices between the central office and customer premises . The fiber optic connectors are critical for linking the OLT, splitters, and ONUs/ONTs, ensuring low insertion loss, high uniformity, and reliable signal transmission .

Common PON Fiber Modules and Connectors

PON systems use various transceiver modules and connector types:

- Modules/Form Factors: XFP, SFP, SFP+, SFP-DD, SFP28, QSFP112, with PON SFP and PON SFP+ being the most widely deployed .
- Connector Types: SC (Subscriber Connector) in UPC (Ultra Physical Contact) or APC (Angled Physical Contact) versions are standard for PON splitters and ONTs .
- Stick Modules: Connect user equipment directly to the fiber network at the network edge, often used for ONT connections
