- **Sealed construction:** Tight seals prevent the ingress of flammable gases or dust, reducing the risk of ignition .
- **Thermal management:** Advanced cooling systems dissipate heat from electrical components, minimizing the chance of overheating and sparks .
- **Monitoring systems:** Some boxes integrate sensors to track temperature, pressure, and gas levels for early hazard detection
