

Weight Standards for Galvanized Cable Trays



Article Overview

The standard weight of galvanized steel cable trays typically ranges from 10 to 30 kg per meter, depending on tray type, dimensions, and material thickness.

Material Density and Calculation

Galvanized steel cable trays are usually made from mild steel with a density of 7850 kg/m³. The weight of a tray is calculated by multiplying the volume of the tray structure (including side rails, rungs, and cross-bars) by the material density. Hot-dip galvanization adds a minimal extra weight, generally accounted for in engineering calculations.

Typical Tray Types and Weights

- Ladder trays: These have two side rails with rungs spaced typically 200-300 mm apart. A standard 6-meter run of galvanized ladder tray can weigh around 28 kg.
- Perforated trays: Material is removed during punching, reducing weight by 15-30% compared to solid-bottom trays.
- Solid-bottom trays: Heavier than perforated trays due to full metal coverage, weight depends on tray width, side height, and sheet thickness.

Factors Affecting Weight

- Tray dimensions: Wider trays and deeper side rails increase the developed metal area, raising weight per meter
