

Welding for Trough-Type Cable Trays



Article Overview

Trough-type cable trays are secured using a combination of welding to support structures and bolted fasteners, ensuring mechanical stability, proper alignment, and electrical safety.

Welding to Support Structures

Trough-type cable trays are often mounted on MS (mild steel) support structures such as wall-mounted angles or C-channels. Welding is used to attach the tray supports or bridge structures to existing metal frameworks, particularly for long spans or heavy cable loads. The welding should be performed at regular intervals (e.g., every 1 meter) to maintain structural integrity and prevent sagging under load. After welding, the joints should be coated with primer and enamel paint to prevent corrosion and ensure a smooth finish .

Bolted Fastening

For connecting individual tray sections, high-tensile bolts, washers, and nuts are used. Typically, M8 bolts with coupler plates are employed to join two tray sections securely. Eight hardware sets per joint are recommended to ensure stability. Field drilling may be required to align holes for bolts, especially when using solid-bottom trays .
