Core Network Rack Devices

- Routers: Direct network traffic between different networks and manage IP routing .
- Patch Panels: Organize and route network cables efficiently, simplifying changes and maintenance .
- Servers: Provide computing power for applications, databases, and virtualization .
- Firewalls: Protect the network by filtering traffic and blocking unauthorized access .
- Storage Devices (NAS/SAN): Centralized storage for backups, file sharing, and disaster recovery .
- Uninterruptible Power Supply (UPS): Ensures continuous power during outages, protecting sensitive equipment .
