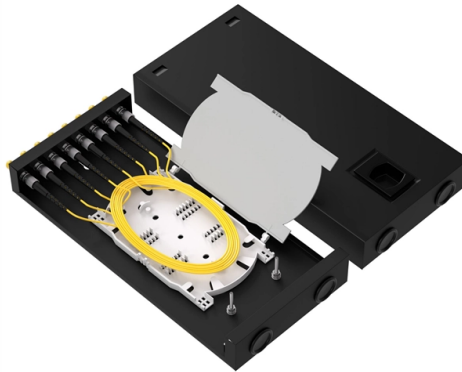


What are optical ports and electrical ports on a switch

Optical ports use fiber optics for long-distance, high-speed data transmission, while electrical ports use copper cables for shorter distances and lower speeds.

Overview

Optical ports on switches are designed to transmit data over fiber optic cables. They typically require the insertion of optical modules, such as SFP or QSFP, which convert electrical signals into light signals for transmission. Optical ports support high-speed data rates ranging from 1.25G to 100G and can transmit data over distances up to 100 kilometers, depending on the module and fiber type used . Common interface types include LC, SC, MPO, and sometimes RJ45 when using electrical port modules in optical slots . Electrical ports, on the other hand, transmit data over copper Ethernet cables (UTP). They are usually integrated with the switch and use RJ45 connectors, eliminating the need for optical-electrical conversion . Electrical ports support speeds from 10M to 10G, with transmission distances limited to around 100 meters for standard Ethernet cables. For speeds of 1G and below, Cat5 or Cat6 cables are sufficient, while 10G requires Cat6A or higher .

Port Modules

Electrical ports can also be implemented as hot-swappable SFP electrical port modules, which allow existing copper cabling to connect to SFP slots on switches or NICs. These modules support Fast Ethernet (100M), Gigabit (1G), and 10G speeds
