Using three connectors on a fiber optic cable increases signal loss, maintenance complexity, and potential points of failure.

Signal Loss and Attenuation

Each connector introduces insertion loss, which is the reduction in signal strength when light passes through the connection. Typical connector losses range from 0.2 dB to 0.75 dB per connector, depending on type and quality . With three connectors, the cumulative loss can significantly weaken the signal, especially in long-distance or high-bandwidth applications . Additionally, connectors are prone to extrinsic losses caused by misalignment, end-face defects, or contamination, which further degrade performance .

Increased Maintenance Requirements

More connectors mean more points that require regular cleaning and inspection. Dust, dirt, or scratches on any connector can cause signal degradation or complete failure . Maintaining three connectors increases labor and operational costs, as each connection must be carefully handled to ensure optimal performance .

Reliability and Durability Concerns

Connectors are generally less durable than splices and can be damaged by bending...
