

What are the methods for bending and fixing mesh cable trays



Article Overview

Mesh cable trays can be bent on-site using cutting and manual bending techniques, then fixed securely with clamps, supports, and protective measures to ensure safe and professional cable routing.

Bending Techniques

1. Horizontal 90° Bend (Flat Bend) Used to turn the tray left or right. Mark the bend area, cut selected wires partially with a bolt cutter, and bend the tray manually to the desired angle, ensuring the bend radius accommodates cable requirements . 2. Vertical Bend (Up/Down Bend) Used to move the tray between levels. Similar to horizontal bends, mark the area, cut necessary wires, and bend upward or downward carefully, supporting the tray to prevent deformation . 3. Tee (T-Junction) and Cross (4-Way Junction) For branching or multi-directional routing, cut and bend sections to form a T or cross. Use clamps or connectors to join the new branch securely to the main tray . 4. Offset Bend (Side Shift) Used to avoid obstacles. Cut and bend the tray sideways while maintaining cable bending radius and structural support .

General Rules for Bending

- Avoid cutting all wires completely.
- Do not create overly sharp bends.
- Support the bend area during manipulation.
- Maintain proper cable bending radius.
- Smooth sharp edges with a file to prevent cable damage
