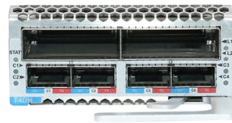


What are the methods of distribution network automation



Article Overview

Substation and Feeder Automation

This method integrates automation at distribution substations and feeders to share common monitoring and control equipment. It includes supervisory control of circuit breakers, load tap changers (LTCs), voltage regulators, reclosers, sectionalizers, switches, and capacitor banks. Remote data acquisition allows utilities to monitor system performance, balance transformer loads, and adjust voltages during peak demand or emergency situations, enhancing reliability and efficiency of the distribution network .

Consumer Location Automation

Automation at the consumer level enables utilities to remotely read meters, program time-of-use (TOU) meters, connect or disconnect services, and control consumer loads. This method improves operational efficiency, reduces manual intervention, and allows for better demand-side management .
