These cables terminate at the patch panel, which is mounted inside a network rack or cabinet. A network patch cord (or Ethernet patch cable) connects networking devices such as switches, routers, and patch panels. Though small, it plays a key role in maintaining signal integrity and stable data transmission across LAN and data center environments. A patch cord is a precise assembly of. Instead of allowing cables to run directly between devices, a patch panel provides a centralized termination point where all permanent cabling is neatly arranged and then connected to active networking equipment using short patch cords.
