

What cable to use when configuring the core switch

Use a rollover (console) cable for initial configuration and fiber optic cables with appropriate SFP/SFP+ transceivers for inter-switch connections.

Initial Configuration

When first configuring a core switch, you typically connect a computer to the switch's console port. For this purpose, use a rollover (console) cable, which is often flat and has an RJ-45 connector on one end and a DB-9 or USB adapter for your computer on the other. You will also need terminal software like PuTTY to establish a serial connection at 9600 baud rate to access the switch CLI and perform initial setup tasks such as setting hostnames, VLANs, and IP addresses .

Interconnecting Core Switches and Other Devices

For high-speed connections between core switches, aggregation switches, or firewalls, fiber optic cables are recommended, especially for longer distances or higher bandwidth requirements. Key points include:

- Transceivers: Insert the correct SFP or SFP+ transceiver into the switch port that matches the fiber type (single-mode or multi-mode) and speed requirements .
- Cable Type: Use multi-strand pre-terminated fiber optic cables with LC connectors for reliable, low-loss connections. These cables are factory-tested and reduce installation time and errors
