Grounding Bus Bar: Directs excess current safely into the ground during faults, preventing shocks and fire hazards .
Enclosure: The outer casing, typically made of durable materials like polycarbonate, ASA, or epoxy-coated stainless steel, protects internal components from dust, moisture, and physical damage .
Electrical Wiring: Connects all components and circuits, including provisions for specialized equipment like solar panels .
Surge Protective Device (SPD): Protects the system from sudden voltage spikes caused by lightning or phase-to-phase faults .
Indication Lights: Provide visual status of the main power supply, allowing quick checks of system operation
