

What do transparent transmission and aggregation mean in a switch

In switches, "aggregation" refers to combining multiple physical links into a single logical link for higher bandwidth and redundancy, while "transparent transmission" allows VLAN-tagged traffic to pass through a switch without modification.

Aggregation

Aggregation, often called link aggregation, is the process of bundling multiple physical Ethernet ports into a single logical interface, known as an aggregate link or link aggregation group (LAG). This provides several benefits:

- Increased bandwidth: Traffic is distributed across all member ports, allowing the combined bandwidth to exceed that of a single link .
- Redundancy and reliability: If one member port fails, traffic automatically shifts to the remaining ports, maintaining connectivity .
- Simplified management: The switch treats the aggregated ports as a single interface, applying protocol configurations and VLAN settings at the aggregate level rather than individually on each port . Aggregation can operate in static mode, where the configuration is fixed, or dynamic mode, using protocols like LACP (Link Aggregation Control Protocol) to negotiate link bundling automatically .
