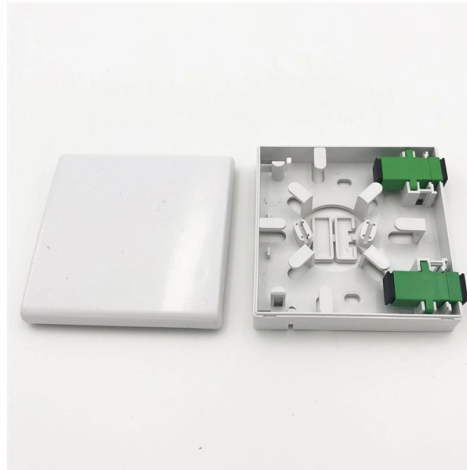

What is PON?

A Passive Optical Network (PON) is a fiber-optic telecommunications network that connects a central service provider to multiple end users using unpowered (passive) optical components like splitters . Unlike active networks, PON does not require powered devices between the central office and the user, which reduces maintenance costs and improves reliability . Key components of a PON include:

- Optical Line Terminal (OLT): Located at the service provider's central office, it manages data transmission to and from multiple users .
- Optical Distribution Network (ODN): Passive fiber and splitters that distribute signals from the OLT to end users .
- Optical Network Units (ONUs) or Optical Network Terminals (ONTs): Devices near t...
