An LC type tail fiber is a fiber optic patch cord with an LC connector on one end and a bare fiber on the other, commonly used for high-density single-mode or multimode connections.

Overview of LC Tail Fibers

An LC type tail fiber is a short optical fiber cable terminated with an LC connector on one end and a bare fiber core on the other, designed for fusion splicing to incoming fiber cables in the field. The LC connector features a 1.25 mm ferrule and a push-pull latch, making it ideal for high-density installations such as SFP/SFP+ and QSFP transceivers. LC tail fibers are widely used in fiber optic termination boxes, ODFs, and data center patch panels.

Classification

Tail fibers, including LC types, are classified based on fiber mode, core count, and color coding :

- Fiber Mode:
 - Single-mode (SM): Yellow jacket, operates at 1310 nm or 1550 nm, suitable for long-distance transmission (10–40 km).
 - Multimode (MM): Orange jacket, operates at 850 nm, suitable for shorter distances (~500 m).
- Core Count: Single-core, 4-core, 6-core, 8-core, 12-core, 24-core, etc., depending...
