An outdoor single-mode optical cable is a fiber optic cable designed for long-distance, high-speed data transmission in outdoor environments, using a single light mode to minimize signal loss.

Definition and Structure

A single-mode optical cable carries only one mode of light through a very narrow core, typically 8–10 micrometers in diameter, which reduces modal dispersion and allows signals to travel long distances without significant attenuation. Outdoor single-mode cables are usually constructed with a loose-tube design, which protects the fiber from environmental stresses such as temperature fluctuations, moisture, and mechanical impact. This design contrasts with indoor single-mode cables (OS1), which are tight-buffered and optimized for short-distance, controlled environments.

Types and Standards

Outdoor single-mode fibers are commonly classified as OS2, designed for long-distance outdoor applications. OS2 fibers support distances up to 200 km and can handle high-speed transmissions, including Gigabit, 10G, 40G, and 100G Ethernet. They operate at wavelengths of 1310 nm and 1550 nm, which are less prone to attenuation and suitable for telecom and data backbone networks. The widely used standards for single-mode fibers include ITU-T G.652 and G.657, ensuring compatibility with modern Dense Wavelength Division Multiplexing (DWDM) system...
