Overview

Earth fault protection based on measured or calculated residual current values: If a breaker fails to be triggered by a tripping order, as detected by the non-extinction of the fault current, this backup protection sends a tripping order to the upstream or adjacent breakers. Core idea: Protective relays monitor electrical quantities and command protective devices to isolate faults or abnormal operating conditions.
