

What is a Passive Optical Network PON provider

A PON provider is a service provider that delivers high-speed broadband to multiple customers using a fiber-optic network with passive splitters, minimizing the need for powered equipment between the central office and end users.

What a PON Provider Does

A PON provider uses fiber-optic technology to connect a central office or hub to multiple homes, businesses, or other endpoints without requiring powered devices along the distribution path . The provider installs an Optical Line Terminal (OLT) at the central office, which sends data downstream to multiple Optical Network Units (ONUs) or Optical Network Terminals (ONTs) at customer locations . Passive optical splitters divide the signal from a single fiber to serve many users, reducing the number of fibers and equipment needed compared to traditional point-to-point networks .

Key Components

- Optical Line Terminal (OLT): Located at the provider's central office, it manages data transmission to and from all connected users .
- Passive Splitters: Unpowered devices that split the optical signal to multiple fibers, enabling one fiber to serve many endpoints .
- Optical Network Units (ONU) / Optical Network Terminals (ONT): Devices at the customer premises that receive and transmit data to the OLT
