

What is a standard elbow for cable trays



Article Overview

Standard elbows for cable trays are metal or composite fittings designed to route cables around corners, typically available in 45° and 90° angles, with materials and sizes matched to the tray system.

Types and Angles

Cable tray elbows are primarily available in 90° and 45° angles, allowing smooth directional changes in cable runs (). Some systems also offer large-radius elbows for gentle bends, which help maintain the minimum bend radius of cables and reduce mechanical stress ().

Materials

Elbows are commonly made from steel, aluminum, stainless steel, or glass fiber reinforced polyester (GRP). Steel and aluminum provide high mechanical strength and corrosion resistance, often with galvanized or painted surfaces for additional protection (). GRP elbows are used in environments requiring chemical resistance or non-conductive properties ().

Design Features

- Perforated or solid side rails: Perforated designs allow ventilation and heat dissipation, while solid designs protect cables from dust and debris ().
- Integrated connector plates: Facilitate secure attachment to straight tray sections.
- Diameter compatibility: Elbows are sized to match the width and height of the cab...
