At the user end, these connectors are critical for FTTH (Fiber to the Home), office networks, and data center applications, providing flexibility for maintenance and upgrades while maintaining low insertion loss and high return loss (signal reflection) performance .

Common User-End Connector Types

- SC (Subscriber Connector)
 - Square-shaped with a push-pull mechanism.
 - Uses a 2.5mm ferrule.
 - Popular in FTTH and GPON networks where low return loss is essential .
- LC (Lucent Connector)
 - Miniaturized version of SC with a 1.25mm ferrule.
 - Latch mechanism similar to RJ45 plugs.
 - Ideal for high-density applications like routers, switches, and data centers .
- ST (Straight Tip)
 - Round shell with bayonet coupling....
