Unlike multimode SFPs, single-mode modules are optimized for long-range communication, making them ideal for campus backbones, metro networks, and telecom applications.

Technical Characteristics

- **Fiber Type:** Single-mode fiber with a core diameter of approximately 9 μm and cladding of 125 μm .
- **Wavelengths:** Typically operates at 1310 nm or 1550 nm, which are suitable for long-distance transmission.
- **Transmission Distance:** Can range from 2 km up to 120 km, depending on the module type and optical power budget.
- **Form Factor:** Small Form-factor Pluggable (SFP), which is hot-swappable and compact, allowing high port density on networking equipment....
