LC connectors, originally developed by Lucent Technologies, are compact fiber optic connectors designed for both single-mode and multimode fibers. They use a 1.25 mm ceramic ferrule, which is half the size of the SC connector's 2.5 mm ferrule, allowing for higher port density in patch panels, switches, and transceivers. The push-pull latch mechanism provides a secure connection while making insertion and removal easier compared to threaded or bayonet-style connectors.

- High-density design: LC connectors double the port density compared to SC, FC, or ST connectors, making them ideal for modern data centers and enterprise networks.
- Duplex capability: Often used in duplex configurations for full-duplex communication, supporting simultaneous transmit and receive channels.
- Compatibility: Fully aligned with TIA/EIA-604 standards, ensuring cross-vendor interoperability.
- Applications: Commonly found on SFP/SFP+/SFP28 modules, fiber patch panels, transceiver ports, and WDM hardware.
- Performance: Provides low insertion loss and high return loss, ensuring efficient light transmission and minimal signal degradation.
