

What is the appropriate distance between a level 3 electrical distribution box and a power distribution box



Article Overview

The distance between a level 3 electrical distribution box and a power distribution box should not exceed 30 meters, with sufficient working space around each box for safe operation and maintenance.

Recommended Distance

For level 3 electrical distribution systems, the horizontal distance between a distribution board and a switch box or power distribution box should ideally be minimized to reduce voltage drop and improve efficiency. According to industry guidelines, this distance should not exceed 30 meters (approximately 98 feet) from the main distribution board to the switch box, while the distance between a switch box and its controlled fixed electrical equipment should preferably be no more than 3 meters (10 feet) to ensure operational efficiency and safety .

NEC Working Space Requirements

The National Electrical Code (NEC 2023) mandates clearances around electrical panels and distribution equipment to allow safe access for maintenance and operation:

- Depth: Minimum of 3 feet (900 mm) in front of the panel or distribution box
