

What is the appropriate size for a three-way cable tray

3-way cable tray fittings are designed to match the width and depth of the main tray, typically ranging from 50mm to 900mm in width and 25mm to 150mm in depth, depending on tray type and load requirements.

Standard Dimensions

Width: 3-way fittings are manufactured to align with the main cable tray width. Standard widths for industrial and commercial applications typically range from 50mm to 900mm, with narrower trays (100–150mm) used for control or instrumentation cables and wider trays (600–900mm) for heavy power or fiber optic bundles . **Depth/Side Rail Height:** The vertical dimension, or side rail height, usually ranges from 25mm to 150mm, depending on cable volume and ventilation needs. Ladder trays often require higher side rails for heavy loads, while perforated or wire mesh trays may have shallower depths . **Length:** While straight tray sections are commonly 3 meters (10 feet) long, 3-way fittings are shorter and designed to connect three tray runs at a junction. The exact length varies by manufacturer but is generally proportional to the tray width and depth to maintain structural integrity . **Material Thickness:** The thickness of the fitting should match the main tray to ensure load capacity and durability. Heavy-duty trays typically use 2.5mm or greater thickness with reinforced side rails for maximum support .
