

What is the baseline for network security devices

A network security baseline is a formally defined set of minimum security configurations for network devices, serving as a reference point to ensure consistent, secure operations and detect deviations.

Definition and Purpose

A network security baseline is a documented, approved configuration for devices such as routers, switches, firewalls, servers, and wireless access points, representing the minimum required security settings and controls for safe operation . Its primary purpose is to provide a standardized reference against which all devices are configured and maintained, reducing vulnerabilities, supporting compliance, and ensuring consistent defense against cyber threats .

Key Components

Security baselines typically include:

- Technical Controls: Firewalls, access control lists (ACLs), intrusion detection/prevention systems, secure protocols, and patch levels .
- Administrative Controls: Policies, procedures, user access management, and security training .
- Physical Controls: Secure facility access, locked server rooms, and monitoring systems
