

What is the core switch configuration

Configuring a core switch involves setting up hardware modules, VLANs, VPN instances, interface IPs, and routing protocols to ensure scalable, secure, and efficient network connectivity.

Hardware Considerations

Slots and Modules: Core switches have multiple slots for installing function and interface modules. Each module provides a set number of ports, so the number of slots determines the switch's scalability and port capacity. Functional modules may include super engine modules, IP voice modules, network monitoring modules, and security service modules. Interface modules can support LAN, WAN, ATM, or high-speed connections like 10Gbps SFPs to meet complex network requirements .

Backplane Bandwidth: The backplane connects all interface modules and processors. Its bandwidth determines the maximum data transfer rate between ports. A higher backplane bandwidth ensures faster inter-port communication and reduces bottlenecks in high-traffic environments .

Software and Network Configuration

VLANs and VPN Instances: Create interconnection VLANs to link the core switch with BRASs and firewalls. For each VLAN, configure a VLANIF interface and bind it to a VPN instance to isolate public network routes from return traffic from firewalls . This ensures secure and segmented traffic flow.

Interface IPs: Assign IP addresses to interfaces connecting the core switch to other network devices. This is essential for routing and management. Ensure that each interface is correctly mapped to its VLA...
