The end of a fiber optic cable is prepared either with a connector for removable connections or a splice for permanent connections, ensuring minimal signal loss and reliable data transmission.

Fiber Termination Overview

The fiber optic cable end refers to the point where the optical fiber is prepared to connect to another fiber, device, or network. Proper termination is critical to maintain signal integrity, reduce light loss, and protect the delicate glass core from damage or contamination (). There are two main methods for terminating fiber optic cables:

- Connector Termination
 - Involves attaching a removable connector to the fiber end, allowing it to plug into patch panels, switches, or other equipment ().
 - Common connector types include LC, SC, ST, FC, and MTP/MPO, each with unique features such as size, insertion loss, and durability ().
 - The process typically includes stripping the cable jacket, cleaving the fiber, inserting it into a connector with a ceramic ferrule, and securing it with epoxy or mechanical means ().
 - Advantages: quick installation, removable, low initial cost, suitable for high-density environments.
 - Disadvantages: slightly higher signal loss compared to splicing, multiple connector types must be managed, and long-term stability is lower than permanent splices.

 - Creates a permanent joint between two fibers, either by fusion splicing (using an...
