

What is the fiber optic cable plugged into the router

A fiber optic cable cannot usually be plugged directly into a standard router; it must first connect to an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) or a router with a dedicated fiber port.

Understanding the Connection

Fiber optic internet transmits data as light signals, which standard routers cannot interpret directly. The Optical Network Terminal (ONT), typically provided by your ISP, converts these light signals into electrical signals that your router can use. The fiber cable from your ISP connects to the ONT's optical port, and the ONT then outputs data through an Ethernet port to your router.

Steps to Connect Fiber Internet

- **Install the ONT:** Locate the fiber wall outlet and plug the fiber optic cable into the ONT's designated port. Power on the ONT and wait for the status lights to stabilize.
- **Connect the ONT to the Router:** Use a high-quality Ethernet cable (Cat6a or higher) to link the ONT's Ethernet/LAN port to your router's WAN port.
- **Power On and Configure the Router:** Turn on your router and wait for the indicator lights to confirm a successful connection. Access the router's configuration interface if manual setup is required.
- **Verify the Connection:** Check your devices to ensure internet access is working properly
