Fiber optic arrays are primarily made from ultra-pure silica glass or plastic fibers, with specialized coatings, cladding, and protective layers to ensure efficient light transmission and durability.

Core and Cladding Materials

The core of a fiber optic strand, where light signals travel, is typically made from ultra-pure silica (SiO_2), sometimes doped with germanium or phosphorus to slightly increase the refractive index and optimize light propagation. Surrounding the core is the cladding, which has a slightly lower refractive index to confine light within the core through total internal reflection. Cladding materials are often silica doped with fluorine or boron for precise optical control. For short-distance or flexible applications, plastic optical fibers (POF) may be used for both core and cladding, offering easier handling but higher signal loss over long distances.

Coatings and Protective Layers

Fiber optic arrays include dual-layer UV-cured acrylate coatings: a soft primary coating to cushion the glass and a hard secondary coating for mechanical protection. Additional protective layers may include buffer tubes, aramid yarn (Kevlar), FRP rods, steel armoring, and HDPE or LSZH jackets to enhance tensile strength, moisture resistance, and environmental durability. Color-coded UV-cured inks are often applied for fiber identification in multi-fiber arrays ...
