

What is the maximum number of circuits a distribution box can hold

The maximum number of circuits a distribution box can hold depends on the panel's design and manufacturer specifications, typically ranging from 20 to 42 slots, with the potential for more circuits using tandem breakers.

Panel Design and Breaker Slots

The physical design of the panel determines the number of breaker slots available. Standard residential panels, such as a 200-amp panel, usually have 30 to 42 slots, where each slot can hold a single-pole breaker for a 120-volt circuit or half of a double-pole breaker for a 240-volt circuit . Double-pole breakers occupy two adjacent slots and are used for high-power appliances like ranges or dryers .

Tandem (Duplex) Breakers

Some panels allow the use of tandem breakers, which fit two independent circuits into a single slot. This can effectively increase the number of circuits beyond the physical slot count, but only if the panel is rated for tandem breakers in those positions . For example, a 20-slot panel could support up to 40 circuits if all slots are approved for tandem breakers .
