

What is the spacing between cable tray columns



Article Overview

Cable tray columns should be spaced according to tray type, load, and installation standards, typically ranging from 6 to 20 feet depending on span and environmental conditions.

Support Span Guidelines

The spacing of cable tray supports (columns or hangers) depends on the tray type, load, and installation environment. For short-span trays in indoor, non-industrial settings, supports are generally placed every 6 to 8 feet. Intermediate-span trays are supported every 10 to 12 feet, while long-span trays may require supports at 14 to 20-foot intervals, with 20 feet being common. Extra-long spans exceeding 20 feet are used in outdoor or special applications, such as crossing roads, to reduce the number of supports required .

Column and Vertical Support Considerations

Vertical cable tray runs require sturdy columns or hanging rods, typically at least 8 mm in diameter, to ensure stability and prevent stress on cables. Proper vertical spacing prevents sagging, maintains cable order, and allows for heat dissipation and maintenance access . For installations in suspended ceilings, a minimum vertical clearance of 80 mm from the cover access side is recommended .
