Galvanized steel is cost-effective and suitable for mild to moderate corrosion environments, such as commercial buildings or urban areas . **Aluminum:** Naturally corrosion-resistant and lightweight, aluminum trays are ideal for commercial or indoor applications where moderate corrosion protection is sufficient. They are easy to install and aesthetically appealing, though they have lower structural strength compared to stainless steel . **Fiberglass (FRP):** Fiberglass-reinforced plastic trays are non-metallic and immune to rust, making them excellent for highly corrosive environments, including chemical plants, wastewater facilities, and refineries. FRP trays offer superior chemical resistance but lower mechanical strength than metal trays .
