

What quota is required for optical fiber cables

A common practice is to add 20% spare fibers to your calculated requirement and select the nearest standard cable size, ensuring future scalability and ease of maintenance.

Determining Fiber Count

When planning fiber optic deployments, the fiber quota should account for current usage plus spares for testing, repairs, and future expansion. A practical rule is to add approximately 20% extra fibers to your initial requirement. For example, if your project requires 60 fibers, multiplying by 1.2 gives 72 fibers, which can then be matched to the nearest standard cable size such as 72 or 96 fibers .

Standard Cable Sizes and Subunits

Fiber cables are typically manufactured in standard counts: 2, 6, 12, 24, 48, 72, 144, and higher. Using 12-fiber subunits is common for modularity and easier termination. For instance, 72 fibers can be organized as 6 × 12-fiber subunits, keeping terminations tidy and simplifying future upgrades .

Optical fiber networks are highly scalable. Modern fiber can support multi-gigabit speeds for decades, and the physical fiber itself has a lifespan exceeding 35 years
