

What quota should be applied to the optical line terminal OLT

OLT quotas are typically applied via T-CONTs and DBA profiles to manage upstream bandwidth per ONU, with service-port traffic limits controlling downstream allocation.

Understanding OLT Quotas

In a GPON or PON network, the quota refers to the bandwidth allocation for each ONU/ONT or service type. This ensures fair usage, prevents congestion, and guarantees service quality for Internet, VOIP, IPTV, or other services. Quotas are implemented using:

- T-CONTs (Transmission Containers): Logical channels on the OLT that define upstream bandwidth allocation for each ONU. Each T-CONT is associated with a DBA (Dynamic Bandwidth Allocation) profile that specifies guaranteed and maximum bandwidth limits.
- DBA Profiles: Define upstream traffic parameters dynamically, allowing the OLT to adjust bandwidth based on real-time demand, improving utilization efficiency.
- Service-Port Traffic Limits: Control downstream bandwidth per VLAN or service, ensuring that each service receives its allocated quota.

Typical Configuration Approach

- Assign T-CONTs to ONUs: Each ONU can have multiple T-CONTs for different service types (e.g., Internet, VOIP, IPTV). For example, T-CONT 1 for Internet, T-CONT 2 for VOIP....
