

What size cable should be used in a secondary distribution box



Article Overview

The appropriate cable size for a secondary distribution box depends on the load, distance, voltage, and conductor material, with common residential subpanels using #4 AWG copper or #2/0 AWG aluminum for 100A-125A feeders.

Key Considerations

1. Load Calculation: Determine the maximum current the secondary distribution box will carry. This includes all branch circuits connected to the subpanel. Accurate load calculation ensures the cable can handle the expected amperage without overheating or causing fire hazards . 2. Voltage Drop: For longer distances, voltage drop must be considered. Excessive voltage drop can reduce equipment efficiency and cause overheating. Typically, a voltage drop of less than 3% is recommended for feeders . 3. Conductor Material: Copper and aluminum are common. Copper has higher conductivity, so smaller sizes can be used compared to aluminum. Aluminum requires a larger cross-section to carry the same current safely . 4. Standards Compliance: Follow local electrical codes such as NEC (National Electrical Code) in the U.S. or BS 7671 in the U.K. These codes provide ampacity tables and installation guidelines for different cable types and insulation .

Typical Cable Sizes

- 100A subpanel (residential): #4 AWG copper or #2/0 AWG aluminum, depending on distance and voltage drop
