

What size conduit should be used for threading a 6-core fiber optic cable



Article Overview

A 6-core fiber optic cable typically requires a conduit of at least 1 inch for standard indoor/outdoor jackets, and 1.5 inches for more rigid or gel-filled outdoor cables.

Recommended Conduit Sizes

- Indoor/Outdoor 6-core cable with flexible jacket: Use a 1-inch conduit to allow easy pulling and maintain proper bend radius .
- Gel-filled or rigid 6-core outdoor cable: Use at least a 1.5-inch conduit, and in some cases, a 2-inch conduit may be necessary to accommodate the cable's rigidity and breakout points .

Key Considerations

1. Fill Ratio: Industry standards recommend planning for a maximum fill ratio of 40% for initial installations and up to 70-80% for fiber innerducts to allow room for future growth . The fill ratio is calculated by dividing the cable's outer diameter by the inner diameter of the conduit or innerduct. 2. Bend Radius and Pulling: Ensure the conduit allows the cable to be pulled without exceeding its minimum bend radius. For standard conduit runs, limit pull sections to 300-500 feet, and use long-radius sweeps (minimum 36-inch radius for a 2-inch conduit) instead of sharp 90-degree elbows . Pull boxes or handholes should be installed at every direction change exceeding 90 degrees and at intervals of up to 150 meters. 3. Cable Jacket and Breakout Points: Rigid or gel-filled cables require larger conduits because the breakout points, where...
