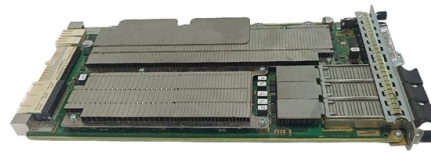


What the server optical module looks like after installation



Article Overview

After installation, a server optical module sits flush in the network adapter or server port, with its handle or latch visible and the fiber connector ready for connection.

Physical Appearance

Once installed, an optical module such as an SFP, SFP+, QSFP, or XFP is fully seated in the port of a network adapter or switch. The module's metal or plastic casing is aligned with the port, and the handle or latch mechanism remains visible on the front, allowing for easy removal if needed . The module is typically rectangular, compact, and may have a label indicating its type, wavelength, or transmission distance .

Orientation and Seating

The module must be correctly oriented before insertion. It is gently pushed into the port until a click or tactile feedback confirms it is securely seated . If the module is not fully inserted, it may pull out slightly when tested, indicating it needs to be reinstalled. Dust plugs are often used on idle ports and should be removed only when connecting fibers .

Fiber Connection

After installation, the fiber optic cable is connected to the module's front interface,...
