

# What to do if your fiber optic router is malfunctioning

If your fiber optic router is malfunctioning, start by checking physical connections, rebooting devices, inspecting hardware, and verifying configuration settings before contacting technical support.

### Step 1: Inspect Physical Connections

If physical connections appear intact, examine the router and related hardware. Restart the router and any connected switches or media converters to resolve temporary glitches . Check indicator lights on the router and transceivers; a “LOS” (Loss of Signal) LED often signals connectivity issues . If possible, swap suspect transceivers with known-good units to isolate hardware failures .

### Step 3: Verify Network Configuration

Configuration errors can also cause malfunctions. Ensure the router's firmware is up...
