Additional structural components, such as aramid yarn (Kevlar®), buffer tubes, and outer jackets made from PVC, PE, or LSZH, provide tensile strength, environmental protection, and durability. In summary, optical fiber cables are classified as composite materials consisting of glass or polymer optical fibers reinforced with polymeric protective and structural layers, making them lightweight, flexible, and resistant to electromagnetic interference. This combination of materials allows fiber optic cables to be used in telecommunications, data centers, industrial, and outdoor applications.
