

What voltage should an industrial switch be connected to



Article Overview

Industrial switches should be connected according to their rated voltage, commonly 24V DC, 48V DC for PoE devices, or 120–240V AC for general industrial circuits.

DC Industrial Switches

For low-voltage industrial control systems, switches often operate on 24V DC, which is standard for factory automation networks and digital I/O modules. This voltage is used to power relays, actuators, sensors, and other control devices safely while minimizing electrical hazards. In industrial PoE (Power over Ethernet) applications, switches typically output 48V DC, following IEEE 802.3af/at/bt standards. This higher voltage allows for long-distance transmission, strong anti-interference capability, and compatibility with cameras, access points, and control terminals. Some devices may also use 12V or 24V DC, but the switch voltage must match the device requirements to avoid damage.

AC Industrial Switches

For general-purpose industrial AC circuits, switches are rated for 120V or 240V AC, depending on the equipment and regional standards. The voltage rating indicates the maximum safe operating voltage for the switch, ensuring it can interrupt current without arcing or failure. Common industrial outlets and switches in the U.S. are designed for 15A or 20A circuits at these voltages, which translates to safe handling of loads up to 1,800–4,800 watts depending on the configuration
