

# When plugging or unplugging the pigtail cable



## Article Overview

Always turn off power before plugging or unplugging a pigtail cable to ensure safety and maintain circuit integrity.

### Safety First

Before handling a pigtail cable, shut off the power at the main breaker and verify the circuit is de-energized using a non-contact voltage tester or multimeter . Wear insulated gloves and safety glasses to protect against accidental shocks or sparks.

### Plugging a Pigtail Cable

- Prepare the wires: Strip about  $\frac{1}{2}$  to  $\frac{3}{4}$  inch of insulation from the ends of the pigtail and circuit wires, ensuring clean, even cuts .
- Twist wires together: Align the bare ends and twist clockwise using lineman's pliers until the strands are tightly bundled .
- Secure with a wire nut: Place a properly sized wire nut over the twisted wires and twist until firmly secured. Gently tug to confirm stability .
- Connect to the device: Attach the free end of the pigtail to the terminal screw or push-in connector of the outlet, switch, or device, ensuring a snug fit .
- Check for proper gauge: Use a pigtail wire of the same gauge and type as the circuit to prevent overheating or code violations .
