- **Optical Distribution Frames (ODFs)** Pigtails are often installed in ODFs, which serve as central points for managing fiber connections in data centers or telecom rooms. The bare fiber is spliced to incoming cables, and the connectorized end is presented on the front panel for easy patching .
- **Fiber Terminal Boxes** In outdoor or building entry points, pigtails are housed in terminal boxes. These boxes protect the spliced connections from environmental factors while providing a convenient interface for connecting to customer premises equipment or network devices .
- **Splice Closures** For underground or aerial fiber runs, pigtails are placed inside splice closures. These closures protect the spliced fibers and allow for organized routing of multiple fiber strands, ensuring low-loss connections
