Relay protection in an RMU is typically integrated within the incomer feeder, often as a microprocessor-based numerical relay mounted inside the RMU enclosure.

Location and Integration

In a Ring Main Unit, the relay protection is usually installed in the incomer feeder section, which is the primary entry point for power into the RMU . This incomer feeder may include a Vacuum Circuit Breaker (VCB) or SF6 Circuit Breaker, along with associated disconnect and earth switches. The relay is mounted inside the RMU enclosure, often near the circuit breaker, and is connected to the feeder to monitor current and detect faults .

Function of the Relay

The relay provides protection against overcurrent and earth faults. When a fault occurs, the relay senses abnormal current or leakage to ground and sends a trip signal to the circuit breaker, which then isolates the faulty section . This ensures that only the affected portion of the network is disconnected, maintaining continuity of supply through the ring network.
